Mr Peter Kerr has been appointed as single Chairperson in this case by Mr Robert Fox, Chairman of the FINA Doping Panel, following FINA Constitution C 22.9 which states that "Whenever necessary the Chair of the Doping Panel shall appoint one or three persons from the Doping Panel to adjudicate all matters before it. No member of the Doping Panel shall be appointed to hear a specific case when he or she is a citizen of the country of the individual or organisation suspected of violating FINA Rules; the Chair of the Doping Panel may also determine situations in which a Panel member should not be appointed due to other potential conflicts."

In the proceedings against

the athlete **Gabriel DA SILVA SANTOS (BRA)** affiliated to the Brazilian Swimming Federation

It was decided in Gwangju (KOR) on 19th July 2019:

Mr Gabriel da Silva Santos is found to have committed an anti-doping rule violation under FINA DC Rule 2.1 – presence of a prohibited substance **Clostebol** in an athlete's sample (Class S1.1.A Exogenous Anabolic Agents).

Mr Gabriel da Silva Santos is sanctioned with a **one (1) year** ineligibility period in accordance with the FINA DC Rule 10.5.2. The sanction starts on 19 July 2019, day of the hearing and will end on 20 July 2020.

All costs of this case shall be borne by the Brazilian Swimming Federation in accordance with FINA DC 12.3.

Any appeal against this decision may be referred to the Court of Arbitration for Sport (CAS), Lausanne, Switzerland not later than twenty-one (21) days after receipt of the complete and reasoned judgement (FINA Rule C 12.11.4 and DC 13.7).
