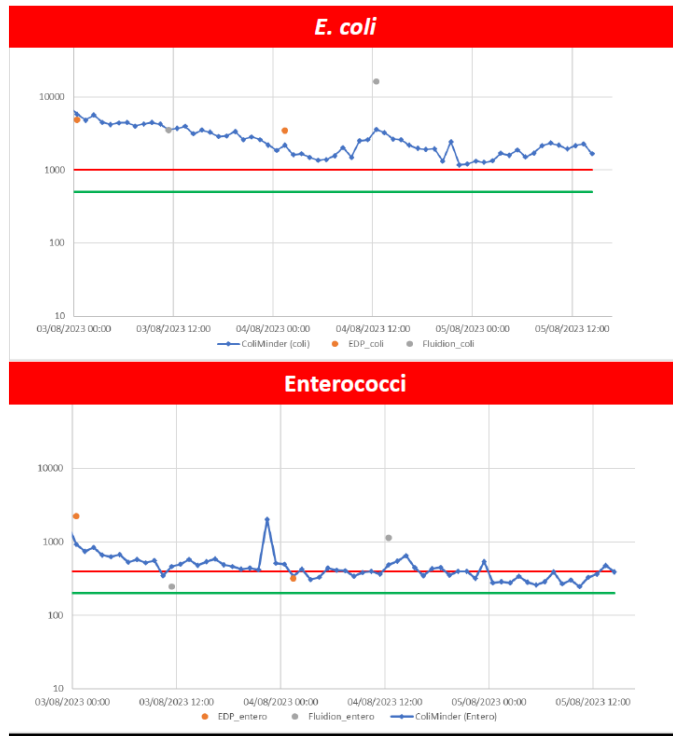
Please see below the latest Information that the Paris Health Authorities have shared with World Aquatics regarding the water quality in the river Seine:

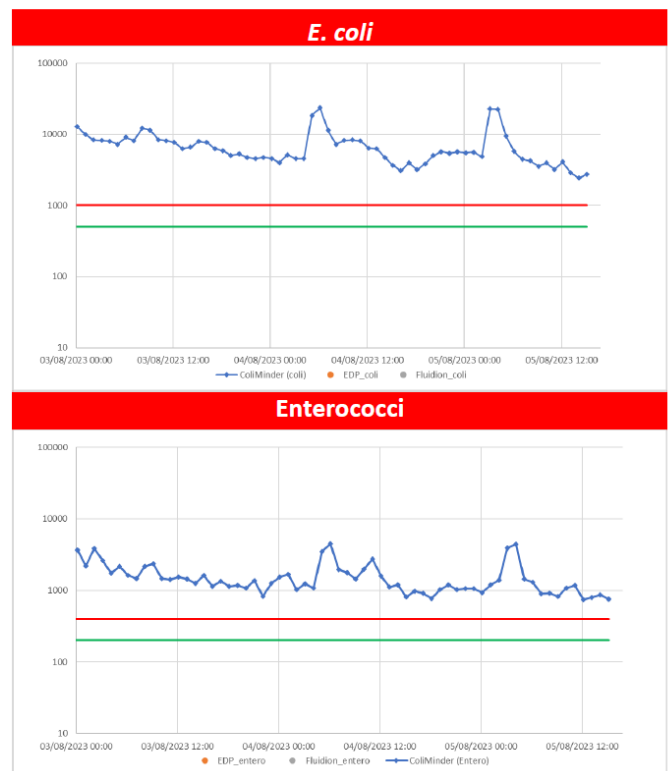
The trend observed by Coliminder at the site is stable after a slight rise in the morning. No spill is expected to reverse this trend:
